NOTICE OF SITE ALTERATION WORKS (NT-2)

Dear Homeowner:


We wish to advise that Site Alteration Works (topsoil stripping and earthworks construction) for Phase 1 of Highland Gate Developments Inc. will be commencing by the end of June, in accordance with the Topsoil Removal Permit's issued by the Town of Aurora.

Every effort will be made to minimize any construction related disruptions.

SCS Consulting Group Ltd. is the Consulting Engineer on this project and will provide the supervision and inspection of the Developer's contractor on the site. We are also available to address any concerns you may have with respect to the construction.

Construction access to the development areas will be provided directly off Bathurst Street. A temporary construction haul road will be constructed, south of Marsh Harbour, as a measure to limit construction traffic on Cranberry Lane during the earthworks phase. See enclosed **Figure C.1** for details.

The development areas under construction have been fenced off and secured. Access to the development areas is strictly prohibited at all times for your safety.



A Construction Impact Mitigation Plan (No. 1 – Phase 1 Site Alteration Works) has been prepared to proactively mitigate potential impacts during the proposed construction program before they arise and address any unforeseen issues. A copy of the Construction Impact Mitigation Plan is posted on the Highland Gate Website. For reference, some of the mitigation measures are outlined below:

1. Construction Hours

As specified in the Town of Aurora Noise By-law, noise prohibitions are required at the following times:

- ●→ 1900 (7:00pm) of one day to 0700 hours (7:00 am) of the next day; and
- All day Sundays and Public Holidays.

2. Dust Control

Elevated dust control measures will be implemented by the General Contractor as required. The mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, watering, use of wind fencing, restrictions during high wind periods, road cleaning, etc.

3. Vibration Monitoring

A vibration monitoring program will be established during these activities to monitor the vibration level to adjacent buildings.
