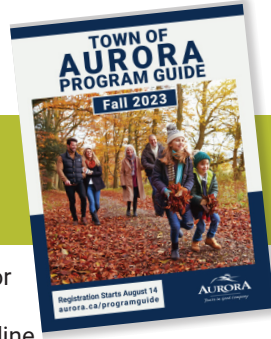
Did you know that Aurora is idle-free?

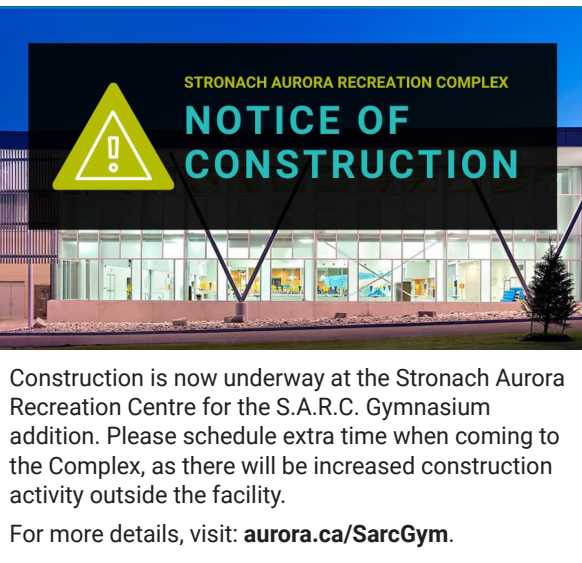
Youth Volunteer Fair
