BLADDER CANCER AWARENESS May 2019

WHEREAS bladder cancer is the 5th most common cancer in Canada and an estimated 9,000 Canadians will be diagnosed with the disease this year; and

WHEREAS bladder cancer has approximately 60 – 70% recurrence rate, making it the most expensive cancer to treat on a per-patient basis; and

WHEREAS Bladder Cancer Canada helps bladder cancer patients and their support teams address day-to-day issues of this disease, increasing awareness of bladder cancer among the general public and medical community and funds research, which pursues the diagnosis, treatments and elimination of bladder cancer; and

WHEREAS increased awareness of bladder cancer among the public and the medical profession can lead to early diagnosis, and the early treatment of this disease can save the lives of many Canadians.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Corporation of the Town of Aurora, hereby proclaims May, 2019 as Bladder Cancer Awareness Month.
